[-Straw bales delivered to GOG. Dave accepting delivery. Bartlett Feed 495-0774](#)

Saturday, 10/5

- Portalets delivered to GOG. Snook directing placement. One ADA at Trading Post near hitching posts. One ADA and one standard at overflow parking. American Portable will contact Snook to coordinate meeting that day.

-Placement of corex Motorless Morning event signs.

-Stage straw bales at slow zone locations off of road.

Sunday, 10/6

4:30 AM John, Snook, Dave, Jackie, Cy & Tristan meet at GOG shop to move straw bales into locations and place banners on bales. Place remaining corex event signs in park.

5:30 AM sharp. Staff arrive at GOG entrance. Bring handheld radio and wear uniform and safety vest.

5:45 AM shuttle arrives at GOGVNC for ADA access. GOGVNC staff will handle shuttle coordination.

Shuttle will be available until 1:00 PM and visitors will have phone number to contact driver for on demand assistance.

6:00 AM sharp. Staff are at assigned location ready to begin event. Trucks need to be parked and running with overhead lights on above all of the slow zones on the side of the road. Trucks at gates are parked and running with lights on.

6:00 AM to 11:30

-Parking attendants begin parking visitors at the overflow. When overflow fills up, park visitors in the RLR field beginning on the north side working towards Rock Ledge. Need cones for overflow parking to designate where parking lanes will begin.

-Slow zone teams in place.

-Gate & Rampart staff in place.

-Dave at Balanced Rock and able to rove as needed.

-Snook at Juniper & Gateway and able to rove as needed.

-Andy Rizzo in Central Garden roving.

-John located at entrance and will be moving throughout the park.

-Volunteer Ambassadors from recreation groups will join staff at slow zones periodically throughout the event.

11:30 Dave & Snook drive around park and alert visitors that the gates will be opening at noon. Staff at

gates and slow zones alert visitors gates opening at noon.

11:45 Slow zone staff take banners down and move straw bales off the road.

Noon, radio out to the all that main gate is opening. Snook opens gate and drives into main entrance with vehicles follow behind him at slow speed. Hayley stops blocking Balanced Rock entrance. Mark and Steven stop blocking Trading Post entrance. Cy opens gate at Ridge Road.

1:00 staff scheduled to assist with straw bales regroup to pick up bales. – Snook, Dave, Jackie, Tristan, Cy, Hayley, Stephanie Fields, Austin and Josh.
